Travel through some of the Botswana's and Zimbabwe's magnificent game reserves. Starting and ending at the spectacular Victoria Falls. Some of the many highlights will include game viewing in Hwange National Park, the Moremi Game Reserve, Greater Khwai and a 2 day Okavango Delta excursion as well as exploring the famous Chobe National Park.

Itinerary

Day 1: Australia - Victoria Falls via Johannesburg. Overnight flight arrive day 2.

Day 2: Victoria Falls. Transfer to the hotel. Remainder of the day at own leisure.

Accommodation: A'Zambezi River Lodge (or similar), Victoria Falls - 2 nights

Day 3: Victoria Falls. Day at own leisure. Optional activities available. (B)

Day 4: Victoria Falls - Caprivi. After breakfast head across the Kazungula border into Namibia, driving through the Caprivi Strip (Zambezi Region) to the camp situated on the banks of the Kwando River. Arrive at the lodge in the late afternoon to enjoy sunset overlooking the river with a chance of seeing both crocodiles and hippos. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Camp Kwando (or similar), Namibia - 1 night

Day 5 - 6: Caprivi - Okavango Delta. This morning embark on an early game drive in the Greater Bwabwata National Park. Cross over the border into Botswana and head to Etsha 13, on the western border of the Okavango Delta. The next day is spent exploring the network of water pathways through thick vegetation in mokoros (traditional dugout canoes), discovering a variety of birds and wildlife. Have the opportunity to stop at a secluded island to take a 1½ hour guided walk hoping to spot elephants, waterbuck or other animals living in this water filled paradise. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Guma Lagoon Camp (or similar), Guma Lagoon - 2 nights

Day 7: Okavango Delta - Khwai River. After breakfast we head south travelling via Maun to the camp which is situated in a private concession in the Khwai River region. The best time for game viewing is the end of the dry season or spring from August to November. During this season, in order for us to offer the best game viewing possible, extra driving may be required due to the animals migrating closer to the river. In the summer, birdlife can also be viewed in abundance with exceptional sightings of wildfowl and raptors. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Bedouin Bush Camp (or similar), Khwai - 3 nights

Day 8: Khwai River. Explore the Khwai River region on morning and afternoon game drives in an open 4x4 vehicle. Enjoy a night game drive to spot some rare nocturnal animals. (B,L,D)

Day 9: Moremi Game Reserve. Today drive to the famous Moremi Game Reserve known as one of the most beautiful and varied reserves in Africa with an unprecedented concentration of wildlife. A full day spent in the unspoiled nature of the Moremi Game Reserve. (B,L,D)

Day 10: Khwai River - Nata. Travel east towards the Makgadikgadi Pans. This area incorporates a vast salt pans and grass plains dotted by palm islands and forms the Great Makgadikgadi which comprises the largest area of salt pans in the world, covering some 37,000km² overall. (B,L)

Accommodation: Nata Lodge (or similar), Nata - 1 night

Day 11-12: Nata - Chobe. Travel to Nata Bird Sanctuary in the morning, for the opportunity to enjoy the magnificent view over the Sowa pan, which is part of the Greater Makgadikgadi Pans (please note a visit to the pans is subject to the road conditions and water levels as well as time constraints). Continue north to Kasane, the gateway to the Chobe National Park. The afternoon is at leisure to partake in optional activities or to relax by the pool. The following day, enjoy a morning game drive in Chobe National Park and a later afternoon boat cruise on the Chobe River. (2B,L,2D)

Accommodation: Chobe Safari Lodge (or similar), Kasane - 2 nights

Day 13 - 15: Chobe - Hwange. Cross the border into Zimbabwe and onto the lodge located in a private concession near to Hwange National Park. This afternoon partake in an optional game drive if time allows (own expense). Over the following two days, we will have plenty of time to explore this vast wilderness on game drives. We will also visit the Painted Dog Conservation Centre to witness the work that is done to protect these endangered species. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Sable Sands (or similar), Hwange National Park - 3 nights

Day 16: Hwange - Victoria Falls. Transfer to Victoria Falls airport where safari ends. Fly to Australia via Johannesburg. (B)

Day 17: Arrive Australia.
